Prayer



ALWC Guiding Principle #4 – Prayer is the highest privilege and the greatest weapon in the life of the believer. **Hebrews 4:16, 2 Corinthians 10:4-5**

Understanding the necessity of prayer is not enough. In order for it to become a part of our life, it needs to become something we look forward to doing. Jesus was a model of prayer and gave His disciples a model and the keys that we can use in growth as joint heirs with Him.

- 1. Prayer is: Talking, listening, and moving with God.
- 2. Prayer is a lifestyle Begin the day in prayer The example of Jesus Mark 1:35
 - a. A Certain Time Jesus got up early in the morning to spend time with His Heavenly Father. In order for prayer to be effective, we should do the same. Make a daily appointment with God and keep it.
 - b. A Certain Place Jesus had a prayer place. Your prayer place needs to be an undistracted environment where you can pray out loud and perhaps have some worship music playing in the background.
 - c. A Certain Plan Go into your prayer time with a plan. If it changes that is fine. When Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, He gave them the Lord's Prayer as an outline.
- 3. The Lord's Prayer the foundational model of prayer that Jesus taught His disciples. **Luke 11:1, Matthew 6:9-13**
 - a. Our Father in Heaven....Connect with God relationally
 - God loves for us to call Him our Father. Establish your intimate relationship with Him and thank Him for the relationship that you have with Him.
 - ii. The revelation of the Father allows us to receive the Spirit of Adoption –Romans 8:15
 - iii. The resurrection of Christ has made us new creations who are the Sons/Daughters of God.
 - b. Hallowed be Your Name...... Worship His Name
 - i. God's name is a place of protection the righteous can run there and be safe. **Proverbs 18:10**
 - ii. God's names reflect His Character that we receive in Christ (completely)
 - iii. Jesus is the name above all names.

- c. Your Kingdom Come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven..... Pray His Agenda First. Matthew 6:33, Luke 12:31
 - i. God's Priorities
 - 1. Manifestation of the Kingdom (Re-establishing Eden).
 - 2. Making Disciples (Unbelievers to believers, believers to worshipers, worshipers to disciples, disciples to disciple makers).
 - 3. Guiding those in authority parental, spiritual, governmental, workplace/marketplace.
 - 4. His will in us.
 - ii. Praying for others before ourselves Job
- d. Give us this day our daily bread..... Depend on Him for everything. Psalm 121:1-2
 - i. Depending on God's supernatural supply for us and others
 - ii. God's only limit is our faith Elisha and the widow.
 - iii. In faith, ask God for what you want and need then trust Him for the answer.
- e. Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.....Get your heart right by forgiving and releasing the debts/offenses/burdens of others.
 - i. Ask God to check your heart and motives. Receive His forgiveness for any area that He brings to mind.
 - ii. Forgive anyone who has offended you in any way. You can even forgive in advance.
 - iii. Jesus gave us the Holy Spirit and the power to forgive and release. John 20:21-23
- f. And do not lead us into temptation but deliver us from the evil one..... Engage in spiritual warfare. **Ephesians 6:12**
 - i. Take your stand against the enemy and fight the good fight of faith.
 Every lie of the enemy should be replaced with the truth of God's Word.
 2 Corinthians 10:4-5
 - ii. The victory/deliverance is already won in Him.
- g. For Your's is the Kingdom and the Power and the Glory forever. Express faith in God's power and your authority. **Jeremiah 32:17**
 - i. End your prayer time by reminding yourself of God's ability. Return to praise and make your faith declarations.
 - 1. Yours is the Kingdom All rule belongs to You.
 - 2. Yours is the Power All mightiness flows from You.
 - 3. Yours is the Glory All the fullness belongs to You.
